- 1.compter (kohm-TEH) silent “m”: to count
- 2.l’oiseau (lwah-ZOH): the bird
- 3.l’arbre (lar-bruh): the tree
- 4.chanter (shohn-TEH) - nasal sound without pronouncing the “n”: to sing
- 5.voir (vwahr): to see
- 6.un (uh(n) (nasal, kind of like “uh” with the sound in your nose): one
- 7.deux (DUH): two
- 8.trois (trwah): three
- 9.quatre (KAT-ruh): four
- 10.cinq (sank) (the “n” is nasal, not strong): five
- 11.les chiffres (SHEEFR): the numbers
- 12.violet (vee-oh-LEH): purple
- 13.orange (oh-RAHNJ): orange
- 14.bleu (BLUH): blue
- 15.rouge (ROOZH): red
- 16.vert (vehr): green
- 17.les couleurs (koo-luhr): the colors
