


# Cristina Juega

Overview

Cristina engages in a dual 'game' with the reader: her playing with a rabbit toy and the narrative's interaction with the audience. The book surprises readers when Cristina's play world shifts, altering the entire story's perspective.

The heart of this book is the secret play space, the dollhouse, where much of the action occurs. Bright colors in the illustrations aim to transport us to a different time and place, emphasizing the themes of play and toys. This approach makes the book a unique and imaginative experience.
