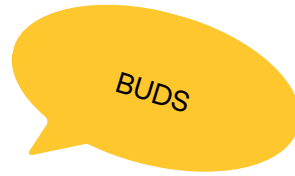


Dodo!

1. faire dodo (fair doh-doh) : to go night night
2. dormir (dor-meer): to sleep
3. tout le monde (too leuh mond): everyone
4. la terre (lah tair): the earth
5. le biberon (leuh bee-beuh-ron) (silent n): the baby bottle
6. le doudou (leuh doo-doo): the blanket / plush toy
7. le soleil (leuh so-lay): the sun
8. la lune (lah loon): the moon
9. les étoiles (lay zay-twahl): the stars
10. fermer les yeux (fair-may lay-zyeuh): to close one's eyes
11. la veilleuse (lah vay-yeuhz): the night light



You need to go to sleep now! It's nighttime. And everyone is sleeping. Your friends are sleeping, your grandparents are sleeping. The birds are sleeping, the cats, the dogs, the unicorns are sleeping. Everyone is sleeping... Even you!
