This playful picture book showcases a series of animals having fun in the woods, while the wolf is at home getting dressed to go there. The forest animals keep shouting over to the wolf to check if he has arrived yet but he consistently answers no as he is adding clothing items. At the end, the wolf shows up ready to eat them all but the animals meet him with a platter of cakes to share and all are happy.

Drawn as bigger and playing together in opposition to the wolf who is smaller and by himself in his tiny home, the forest animals already look very at ease and unbothered by the wolf. They know about the danger, consistently checking in on his arrival but are ready to meet him with a solution to his hunger (cakes). They show courage by facing challenges with a solution and working together while having fun.

The repetition format of the book with two different voice tones makes it fun one for little ones to stay focused while memorizing key words.
