



The little reader can tap, rub, touch, and wiggle illustrations to make an apple tree bloom, produce fruits, and lose its leaves. Written and illustrated by Christie Matheson, it is a perfect introduction to the changing seasons while allowing our little ones to engage in the shifting appearance of an apple tree and understands the beauty of the nature that surrounds us.

What color is the snow? And what season do we get snow?

(A: Snow is white in color. It snows in the winter.)

What happens to the apple tree after counting from one to ten?

(A:The baby birds are hatched and the green leaves are emerging on the tree. Spring has arrived again.)
