5. Ayudar [ah-yoo-DAHR]: to help
6. La espalda [lah ehs-PAL-dah]: the back
7. El lirón [el lee-RON]: the dormouse
8. Despiertar [dehs-per-TAHR]: to wake up
9. Agarrar [ah-gah-RAHR]: to grab/to catch
10. El burro [el BOO-rroh]: the donkey
11. El topo [el TOH-poh]: the mole (animal)
12. Acabo [ah-KAH-boh]: "I just finished"
