This playful book about transportations and rhymes is a great way for children to familiarize themselves with the different modes of transportation and understand their scale from smallest to largest, simplest to more complex (as reflected in the order presented in the book).

The use of character names from different cultural backgrounds can be seen as an attempt to make the story inclusive and relatable, while helping children understand the multicultural world they live in.

The repetitive structure of "name, name, name go by mode_of_transportation" combined with rhymes reinforce children's memorization of such basic Spanish sentence formulations.
